Fees

Cancellation policy

MUKLUKS - \$40

Dates: January 4, 11, & 18

Times: 7:15-8:45pm (doors open at 7:00)

Level: Advanced beginner

Learn two handed stranded colourwork as you create these cozy, traditional mukluks, perfect for cold Canadian winter nights. Learn how to knit an afterthought heel and how to invisibly graft toe stitches together.

Yarn required

- 100g worsted weight yarn (#4) in two contrasting colours

Materials required

- 5mm dpns OR circular needles for magic loop
- Stitch markers

Skills required

- Proficient with knitting and purling in the round



BOYFRIEND SWEATER - \$40

Dates: January 8, 15, & February 5 (homework Jan. 22, 29)

Times: 2:15-3:45pm (doors open at 2:00)

OR 7:15-8:45pm (doors open at 7:00)

Level: Beginner

This classic ribbed sweater is knit in pieces and seamed. We will tackle proper fit and proper finishing techniques such as 3-needle bind off, mattress stitch and setting in sleeves. There is a 2 week break between class 2 and 3 to allow for homework.

Ready to gift for Valentines Day!

Yarn required

- Worsted Weight or Aran (#4). *Whenever possible, for really accurate fit, I recommend measuring and noting the width across the chest, and length from underarm of a sweater you think fits him well.*

Chest sz."	36	40	44	48
Finished sz."	44	48	52	56
Yarn (m)	900	1000	1100	1185

Materials required

- 5mm & 5.5mm needles, straight or circular
- Stitch markers, darning needle

Skills required

- Proficient with knit and purl stitches



LADIES TOP DOWN SWEATER - \$40

Dates: January 22, 29, & February 12 (homework Feb. 5)

Times: 2:15-3:45pm (doors open 2:00)

OR 7:15-8:45pm (doors open 7:00)

Level: Advanced Beginner

This perfect layering sweater, designed by the hugely popular Andrea Mowry of "Find Your Fade" fame, is knit seamlessly from the top down allowing you to try it on as you go. Simple texture on the sides results in a slimming shape, with no shaping required.

Yarn required

- Worsted Weight (#4)

Finished sz."	32	34.25	36.25	38	40	42.25	44.25	46	48
Yarn (m)	870	930	990	1035	1100	1145	1190	1235	1305

Materials required

- 4mm-16" circular; and 4.5mm-32" circular and dpn's
- Stitch markers

Skills required

- Proficient with knitting and purling in the round



BRIOCHE SHAWL - \$40

Dates: February 26, March 5 & 12

Times: 2:15-3:45pm (doors open 2:00)

OR 7:15-8:45pm (doors open at 7:00)

Level: Advanced

Once you start knitting Brioche you will be hooked! A fun, rhythmically repetitive technique with stunning results! A perfect project for using up scraps of sock yarn, or that amazing gradient kit you got for Christmas!

Yarn required

- Fingering (#1) 4 colours--2 light, 2 dark
- Light colour #1: 19g
- Light colour #2: 58g
- Dark Colour #1: 90g
- Dark Colour #2: 53g

Materials required

- 4mm-32" circular; 4mm dpn's x 2



FINGERLESS GLOVES - \$40

Dates: March 1, 8, & 15

Times: 7:15-8:45pm (doors open at 7:00)

Level: Advanced Beginner

These fingerless gloves feature a travelling cable and thumb gusset for optimum fit. Learn directional lifted increases and how to cable without a cable needle.

Yarn required

- Fingering Weight (#1) 100g

Materials required

- 2.75mm & 3.25mm dpns, or long circular for magic loop

Skills required

- Proficient knitting and purling in the round
